

PEST CONTROL FOR VARIOUS PROPERTIES

EMAILED QUESTIONS

Only one question was received by the 8:00 a.m., January 31, 2013 deadline stated in the IFB:

Question:

"...The question is in reference to Scope of Work/General Conditions:

8. Contractor Personnel

Throughout the term of this contract, all Contractor personnel providing on-site pest control service must maintain certification as a Commercial Pest Control Operator per Chapter 482, Florida Statutes. Uncertified individuals working under the supervision of a certified Commercial Pest Control Operator will not be permitted to provide service under this contract.

Can you clarify who you consider certified? All of our technicians are licensed pest control operators."

Answer:

LHA is not qualified to interpret the requirements of this Florida statute. We suggest that your firm contact the Florida *Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services* who is responsible for enforcing the statute or seek an opinion from your firm's legal counsel.

LHA has no intent to impose any requirement on its vendors that is more restrictive than existing laws and governmental regulations.
